



## Welsh National Show & Sale 2014 ALAN CLARK - GARNGOUR/TEIGLUM/CLARKS CJN/CFT/DCX

Alan has been brought up with Texels; with his late father Jim, wisely investing in 2 gimmers from the first importation in 1974. The Garngour flock was later established in 1989. Since then, the flock has again split (although still run as one flock) into 'Teiglum' and more recently 'Clarks', in 2008. The flock, collectively, now numbers 120 ewes.

The 3 flocks have enjoyed many highlights but in 2012 the Teiglum flock sold 5 lambs averaging over £19,000, with a top of 60,000gns for Teiglum Tornado. This is the third time the Clark family have topped the Scottish National sale.

Alan also runs the Nethanvale herd of Holstein cattle at Garngour and was presented with the coveted 'Master Breeder Award' in 2012. He is a past winner of the prestigious 'Stockman of the Year' Award at the Royal Highland Show in 2002. Since then, he has judged numerous shows across the country, including the Royal Ulster.

Alan is a past Regional Director and Board Member, having been Honorary Treasurer of the Society.

Alan is married to Marla and they have 3 children – Finley, Murray & Charlie.
