The flock regularly exhibits at Balmoral Show claiming several championships and at every annual NI National sale. In 2012 Henry had also the honour of judging the Scottish Clubs flock competition.

Henry is currently the Texel Society Chairman and represents Northern Ireland on the Society Board, a position previously held by his mother Barbara. He performs his role within the Society with the support and help from his wife Alice and children Sarah and Robert.
